NOTIFICATION LETTER

June 6, 2022

Dear Neighbors of the 7000 and 7100 blocks of Pioneer Ave,

Please take a moment to read this notice about our upcoming filming in Agassiz on **Monday, June 13th**. Sky Road Productions Ltd. would like to provide some information that will help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our presence may affect your daily routine.

Firstly, we would like to establish that Sky Road Productions Ltd will be implementing the highest standards of Covid-19 safety procedures, following a Worksafe BC approved Covid-19 safety plan. It is imperative that we work together to prevent the disease from infecting our workplace and spreading to our families and the greater community.

The majority of our work will take place along the **7000 block of Pioneer Ave**, as well as **Pioneer Park & The Observer**. There will be no loud noises, stunts or special effects associated with our filming. All our filming consists of exterior scenes.

The following is an outline of our proposed filming dates, times and significant actions:

PREP: Sunday, June 12th

7:00 AM to 7:00 PM: Preparation for filming begins

- A small prep crew will arrive and begin preparing several locations along the 7000 block of Pioneer Ave, and The Observer, 7167 Pioneer Ave
- Temporary No Stopping: Along Pioneer Park side of the street 7130-7098 Pioneer Ave (7AM-7PM) for one of our trucks to set up for filming. Parking will be released for June 13th
- Some antique style set decoration will be placed on the sidewalk between 7098-7056 Pioneer Ave
- No Filming will take place on this day

FILM: Monday, June 13th

9:30 AM to 9:00 PM:

- Intermittent Traffic control will be implemented along the 7000 and 7100 block of Pioneer Ave, with traffic being held for a maximum of **3-minute intervals**. This will occur ONLY while filming scenes along pioneer Ave, and traffic regulations will return to normal once these scenes are complete
- We will be filming exterior scenes around several locations along Pioneer Ave and The Observer
- 7000 Block Pioneer Ave will be dressed as "Country Style Main Street", with benches and country decorations on the sidewalks
- Temporary No Stopping: Along the park side of the street between 7060 and 7086 Pioneer Ave for one exterior scene. As we move down the street parking will be released.
- Essential work truck vehicles will park beside the Agassiz Harrison Museum, 7011 Pioneer Ave
- Temporary no parking from 7086-7079 Pioneer Ave South Side of the Street will release parking once scene is completed
- Picture vehicles will be placed in the lot east of the Agassiz Harrison Observer occupying approximately 8 stalls, for one scene only.

WRAP: Tuesday, June 14th

7:00AM to 7:00 PM:

- A small prep crew will arrive and begin to pack up
- Temporary no stopping between 7130-7098 Pioneer Ave (7AM-7PM) on the North side of the street, for our production truck to wrap up.

In order to minimize disruption to your neighborhood we will park our Film Crew and large Production Vehicles off site at the Community Recreation & Cultural Centre.
