Krypto Films Inc. would like to provide some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine. The District of Kent, Agassiz has asked that we poll your neighbourhood prior to any filming activity

The following is an outline of our filming dates, times, locations, and significant activity.

October 10 Prep Day - 8:00AM to 8:00PM

Reduced crew prepares 6845 Oakwood Drive interior and exterior

October 11 Filming Day (1)

8:00am - Crew will begin to arrive and prepare for a day of filming
10:00am - Filming exterior and interior scenes at 6845 Oakwood Drive.
10:30pm – Crew quietly packs gear there will be security presence after crew leave neighbourhood.

October 12 Filming Day (2) 11:00am to 11:30pm

9:30am Crew will begin to arrive and prepare for a day of filming
11:00am to 11:30pm Filming exterior and interior scenes at 6845 Oakwood Drive
11:00pm– Crew quietly packs gear for the night there will be security presence after crew leave neighbourhood

October 13 Film Day (3) - 12:00noon to 12:30am

10:30am Crew will begin to arrive and prepare for a day of filming
12:00noon to 12:30am Filming exterior and interior scenes at 6845 Oakwood Drive
12:00midnight to 1:30am Crew quietly packs gear into trucks and leave the neighbourhood be security presence after crew leave neighbourhood

To minimize our impact on the neighbourhood, we will be parking our crew vehicles and large trucks off site on private property. However, we will be using driveway areas for support equipment and generator.

Filming work does not involve any loud noises or gunfire or special stunts.
