Agassiz, British Columbia – With the announcement of BC's Restart Plan, the District is continuing to open outdoor recreation spaces for residents to enjoy.

Please note: The Centennial Spray Park remains closed until further notice.

Public Safety guidelines are in effect while using playgrounds and outdoor exercise equipment. These include, staying home if you're sick, 2 metre physical distancing always, sharing the space with others, and washing your hands before and after use.

The phased opening of other indoor and outdoor recreation facilities within the District will transpire in accordance to the Provincial and Fraser Health guidelines to ensure compliance and the safety of all staff and participants.
