



COVID19: Facility Re-Opening

Agassiz, British Columbia – May 28, 2020 The District of Kent is re-opening its facilities to the public with limited services. This decision aligns with the Provincial government's [Restart Plan](#).

Several safety guidelines will be in effect with emphasis on:

1. Staying home if you are sick
2. Hand hygiene
3. Practice physical distancing

On June 1, the Community Recreation and Cultural Centre (CRCC) will resume operations with modified hours as follows:

Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 8:00 pm

Saturday and Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm

Service at the CRCC include select fitness classes, drop in non-contact sports by appointment for the gym, and weight room access will be available with protocols in place.
