Please take a moment to read this notice regarding the filming of scenes for a Christmas TV movie for Hallmark that will be in your neighbourhood from **September 22 to 24, 2022**.

1357697 BC Ltd would like to provide some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine.

The following is an outline of our filming dates, times, locations and significant action:

September 21st: Prep 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- Reduced crew prepares locations for filming

September 22nd: Filming 11:00AM to 11:30PM

- **9:00AM** - Crew will arrive and prepare for a day of filming
- **11:00AM to 11:30PM** - Filming interior and exterior dialog scenes at **3628 Hot Springs Road**
- **11:30PM to 1:00AM** - Trucks get loaded with equipment and crew leave the neighbourhood quietly

September 23rd: Filming 10:30AM to 11:00PM

- **8:30AM** - Crew will arrive and prepare for a day of filming
- **10:30AM to 11:00PM** - Filming interior and exterior dialog scenes
- **11:00PM to 12:30AM** - Trucks get loaded with equipment and crew leave the neighbourhood quietly

September 24th: Filming 9:30AM to 10:00PM

- **8:00AM** - Crew will arrive and prepare for a day of filming
- **9:30AM to 10:00PM** - Filming interior and exterior dialog scenes
- **10:00PM to 12:00AM** - Trucks get loaded with equipment and leave the neighbourhood quietly

September 25th: Wrap 8:00AM to 8:00PM

- Reduced crew comes to restore **3628 Hot Springs Road** to its original condition

In order to minimize our impact on the neighbourhood, we will be parking our work trucks and essential vehicles on private property. Our work does not involve any loud noises or gunfire but there will be snow and Christmas decorations. We will have bright lights on the set, directed only towards our scenes, making the **area appear much brighter than usual**.
