

Schedule of Shared Services & Community Functions

Fraser Valley Regional Library – Agassiz Branch

- \$75,000 of the \$86,000 paid by HHS to FVRL is credited back to DOK
- no funding support from HHS for capital improvements to library – \$40K for new flooring (2024), \$35K for roof replacement (2020), \$800K for construction (2006)

Kent Public Works

- arrangement to provide street sweeping and vacuum truck services at cost recovery

Agassiz Wastewater Treatment Plant

- agreement to accept HHS biosolids (at cost) and combine with Kent biosolids for trucking to disposal site

Emergency Program

- 50/50 shared funding arrangement of Kent Harrison Joint Emergency Program

Fire Department Mutual Aid

- Mutual aid agreement between Agassiz and Harrison Fire Departments

Community Recreation & Cultural Centre

- HHS residents have always had access (at no additional cost) to all the same programs and perks that Kent residents access – Super Senior, advanced swim lesson registration, economic access program, etc.

Agassiz Recycling & Bottle Depot

- Kent provides funding of \$125K per year to support regional recycling, in addition to covering the facility's utilities
- Kent constructed building for \$230K in 2001 and continues to maintain/upgrade as necessary

Agassiz-Harrison Museum

- Kent provides exemption from \$16K in municipal property taxes
- Kent provides \$28K grant for museum operations
- Kent provides \$17.5K as a visitor centre fee-for-service

Kent Harrison Seach and Rescue

- Kent provides exemption from \$17.5K in municipal property taxes
- Kent constructed SAR building for \$670K

Agassiz-Harrison Community Services

- Kent provides exemption from \$22K in municipal property taxes
- Kent provides \$5K for Agassiz-Harrison senior services
