BYLAW NO. 1630.02

“A bylaw to amend Sanitary and Storm Sewer Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 1630”

WHEREAS Section 8(2) of the *Community Charter* authorizes the District of Kent to provide any service that Council considers necessary or desirable;

AND WHEREAS Council previously enacted “Sanitary and Storm Sewer Regulation and Rates Bylaw Amendment No. 1630, 2019”;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the District of Kent, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Sanitary and Storm Regulation and Rates Bylaw Amendment No. 1630.02, 2021” and comes into effect upon adoption.

2. TEXT AMENDMENT

That “Sanitary and Storm Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 1630, 2019” be amended by:

- i. removing the existing Section 9. a) and replacing with the following:

9. DISCONNECTION FROM AND RECONNECTION TO SEWER

- a) Where an Owner requests that a sanitary service be discontinued to the Parcel, the Owner must:

- (1) give a minimum ten (10) business days’ notice in writing to the Engineer;
- (2) be liable for payment of all sanitary user fees until such notice has been received and the service is discontinued; and,
- (3) pay a disconnection fee as set out in Schedule “B” attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.

ii. adding the following to Schedule "B":

2. Monthly Sanitary Sewer User Rates – Agassiz

<u>Property Type</u>	2021	2022	2023
Industrial Wood Dewatering	42.27	43.12	43.98
• Additional Per Kiln (Max 30m ³ /month)	42.27	43.12	43.98

3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this bylaw is, for any reason, held invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the decision that it is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this bylaw.
