# THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF KENT

## BYLAW NO. 1702

*“A bylaw to exempt land held by the municipality from taxation for the year 2023”*

---

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* provides that Council may, by bylaw, exempt from taxation, land, or improvements that are owned or held by a municipality, regional district, or other local authority and that Council considers are used for a purpose of the local authority.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Kent in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

### 1. EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION

The following described property is exempt from land and improvements taxation under the authority of Section 224(b) of the *Community Charter* for the year 2023:

- a) Lot 104, of Section 19, Township 3, Range 28, West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Meridian, Plan 39575, New Westminster District P.I.D. No. 001-388-321, (Folio No. 5320-12715) owned by Linda Tarras and Susan Tarras.

### 2. BYLAW COMES INTO FORCE

This Bylaw shall come into force on January 1, 2023 and ends on December 31, 2023.

### 3. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

- a) “2022 Municipally Held Land Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 1685, 2021” and any amendments thereto are all hereby repealed.
- b) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this bylaw is, for any reason, held invalid by the decision of any court or competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the decision that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this bylaw.

4. TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as "2023 Municipally Held Land Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 1702, 2022".
